## Report by the Commanding Officer



Captain YUEN Ching-fong

I am pleased to present this Report for the Hong Kong Sea Cadet Corps (the "Corps" or HKSCC) for the year 2023. In the wake of the COVID pandemic, the Corps has seamlessly reinstated its comprehensive range of activities, reaffirming our fundamental role in fostering youth development and community engagement. This report highlights the key progress we have made in 2023.

## Continuously Steering the "SEA" Strategy at HKSCC

Thanks to our "SEA" strategy, encompassing sustainability, enrichment and advancement, we continuously adapt and prepare ourselves to navigate the changing landscape of uniform groups in Hong Kong.

## Sustainability

We focus on a succession mechanism to ensure the Corps' going concern.

## The 55th Anniversary of HKSCC (55A)

It is our responsibility to honoring and perpetuating the enduring heritage of HKSCC as we embark more than halfway on our centennial journey. In commemorating momentous the Corps' 55A, a dedicated committee was established to meticulously infuse the essence of this milestone into every facet of the Corps' activities and a specially-designed logo was featured on our T-shirts, invitation materials and displayed across our online platforms.

## Leadership Development

Our pursuit of potential leaders for the Corps fortifies. In line with this goal, we had conducted the Outstanding Cadet Award, the Best Unit Award and a Promotion Board during the Annual Camp held from Aug 18-20. These endeavors are specifically designed to recognise the remarkable accomplishments and valuable contributions made by our officers and



cadets, further solidifying the backbone for the Corps to thrive.

#### Community Service

We have been actively engaged with the community by taking part in various social charity events. Notably, we participated in activities such as the Happy Hong Kong - Yuen Long Farm Festival, the Remembrance Day Ceremony at Cenotaph, the Community Chest Flag Day, the clean shorelines at Sai Kung, and the distribution of lucky bags to elderly living alone as well as the observance of Poppy day.

#### **Enrichment**

We introduce a variety of training programmes and activities to appeal to the different interests of members.

#### Marine Guru Programme (MG Programme)

MG Programme is a bespoke bonding programme between the Marine Police of HKPF and HKSCC with the common objective of nurturing our youth as responsible citizens of Hong Kong and emphasis is placed on the practical application of maritime knowledge. In the reporting year, our cadets had continued to engage in a range of enriching activities, the Corps had periodically reviewed, modified and enhanced the MG Programme in ensuring that our cadets will be greatly benefited and will effectively achieve the programme objectives. In commemorating the 2nd anniversary of the esteemed relationship with the Marine Police and HKSCC, a ceremony was held on 14 August 2023.

## Exchange

In the report year, we successfully reinstated and carried out a comprehensive array of exchange programmes, both inbound and outbound, with astonishing achievements. These exchange programmes have significantly cemented the cultural cultivation of international camaraderie among our cadets, including the traditional international visits to the USA from Jul 17-29 and a special invitation for an exchange to Korea from Jul 30-Aug 13. Moreover, we had the honor of hosting the inbound exchange programme from Aug 13-20 in HK with a total of about 28 participants. Among them, 10 were from Australia, 14 from Singapore and 4 from Japan. We also express our gratitude to the 2 interns from the Marine Police for their valuable assistance. Besides, it is worth mentioning that the "Bound by Unity: Journey Across Million Miles" (同心同根萬里行) programme, organised by the Heart to Roots Association, took 34 cadets on a memorable trip to Beijing, Shanghai, and Wuxi,



China from Jul 17-29. Also, the invitation from the HKSAR Government to Mainland, which is the 2023 PLA Air Force aviation open-day activity, kicked off in northeast China Changchun on July 26-30, and "港澳青年看祖國" in Beijing at Nov 19-23.

In addition to the above, we had organized a series of entertaining activities to provide compelling experiences to our cadets. The "Badges: Preparing Tomorrow's Leaders of Hong Kong Jockey Club" programme served as a unique platform facilitating cross-uniform group interactions and encouraging engagements with external individuals. Other highlights included the enjoyable cruise tours, which featured the Cruise Ship - "Spectrum of the Seas" (海洋光譜號郵輪) and the "World Star" of Star Ferry, an environmentally friendly ferry for a Victoria Harbour Tour with a visit to the Marine Police bases in Hong Kong.

#### **Advancement**

We cultivate a continuous development of the members and the Corps in the growing competitive youth sector.

#### Chinese Style Foot Drill (CSF)

We have achieved an extraordinary year of development of the CSF, surpassing all expectations. The CSF showcased its first full-scale performance at the School Units Passing Out Parade held at the HK Auxiliary Police Headquarters on May 21, and was later displayed at the Annual Parade on Dec 2. Under the leadership of DCO Cdr Ponthey YIP, a systematic training course and a team of qualified in-house instructors were installed which had effectively ensured the CSF implementation process. With this impressive development, we eagerly implement a successful transition to the CSF in 2023 than scheduled at 2024.

#### National Education

The initiative of national education has been promoted by the Hong Kong government in recent years and in the 2023 Policy Address, a focus on sustaining youth development through the implementation and enhancement of measures is stretched in the Youth Development Blueprint. As an integral part of Hong Kong society, HKSCC is actively participating in fostering national and civic education through the different programmes such as the "Family, Nation, Martyrs"(家、國、烈士), a 2-day, 1-night programme at the Sai Kung Bradbury camp held monthly from January to July 2023. Also, the "Leadership Adventure and



Civic Education" (領袖歷奇暨公民教育) activity was organised from Aug 25-26 at Pat Heung JPC Centre. Moreover, visits to the Chinese PLA HK Garrison Exhibition Centre at Ngong Shuen Chau Barracks and the National Palace Museum, as well as participating in the Flag-raising ceremony at GBS and HK Museum of Coastal Defence, and the National Security Education Day at HK Auxiliary Police Headquarters.

#### CORPS' BACKGROUND

The Hong Kong Sea Cadet Corps began to take shape in 1967 by a group of officers of the former Hong Kong Royal Naval Reserve. The formation of the Corps took place on 16th February 1968 and incorporated under the Hong Kong Law (Chapter 1134 – Hong Kong Sea Cadet Corps Ordinance). The Hong Kong Sea Cadet Corps was modeled after and in affiliation with the Sea Cadet Corps of United Kingdom.

Since its inception, the Royal Navy in Hong Kong provided regular support for our officers and cadets, including training resources and facilities. On 1st July 1997, the Corps transformed into an independent uniformed youth organization of Hong Kong and has also been a full member of the International Sea Cadet Association since 1995.

#### **AIMS**

The Corps aims at providing nautical skill, team-building and discipline trainings to its cadet members through maritime activities and to equip them with self-respect, positive value, qualities of leadership, dedication to duty and civic awareness such that they will become contributing citizens of our community.

#### TRAINING ACTIVITIES

In general, training and activities are conducted during the weekends and school holidays, which include:

Life Saving Expedition Personal Development Ceremonial Guard Training Overseas Exchange Programmes



These include manpower assistance to the local charitable organizations for fund raising; providing cadets for crowd control duties during public celebrations and active participation in flag selling days.



#### MANAGEMENT & ORGANISATIONAL STRUCTURES

Policy and directive to run the Hong Kong Sea Cadet Corps are formulated by the Executive Committee under the authority of the Area Committee, which is at present chaired by Ms. LEUNG Tze-wai Jeanie and comprises renowned members of the Hong Kong community who have genuine interest in the promotion of sea training and activities for young people.

The Commanding Officer, Captain Rebecca CF YUEN who is appointed by the Area Committee is the overall operational commander of the Corps. The day-to-day administration is undertaken by the Chief Staff Officer assisted by a team of full-time staff at our Diamond Hill Headquarters.
