Report by the Commanding Officer



Captain YUEN Ching-fong

I am delighted to present this Report for the Hong Kong Sea Cadet Corps (the "Corps" or HKSCC) for the year 2024. This is the fourth and final Commanding Officer's Report during my tenure. As in previous years, the Corps has continued organizing a comprehensive range of activities in reinforcing our core values through cadets' physical participation in community services, interacting with various sectors of Hong Kong to develop the youths' sense of belonging as integral parts of the HK community and benefiting from the positive influences of our volunteers, the Corps nurtures youth to become righteous and contributing citizens.

Continuously Steering the "SEA" Strategy at HKSCC

Through our "SEA" strategy focusing on sustainability, enrichment and advancement, we persistently evolve and equip ourselves to navigate the dynamic landscape of uniformed groups in Hong Kong.

Sustainability

We focus on a succession mechanism to ensure the Corps' going concern.

Promotion

In 2024, 233 cadets and 26 instructors were promoted. Additionally, the Promotion Board held at the Annual Camp from August 9th to 11th and 14 officers were promoted.

Recruitment

Following three challenging years due to the epidemic, we are proactively reengaging in recruitment efforts through various channels. These include launching the "上山下海" recruitment initiative during summer holidays, taking part in the UGs Recruitment Week at the Education University of Hong

Kong and organizing 1-week seamanship and team-building events at Yew Chung International School.

Leadership Development

Our commitment to identifying future leaders within the Corps remains steadfast. In alignment with this objective, we organized the Outstanding Cadet Award, the Best Unit Award, the Grantham Uniformed Youth Groups Outstanding Service Award and a Promotion Board was held during the Annual Camp from August 9th to 11th.

These endeavors are specifically designed to recognise the remarkable accomplishments and valuable contributions made by our officers and cadets, further solidifying the backbone for the Corps to thrive.

The 75th Anniversary of the founding of the People's Republic of China
This year marks the 75th Anniversary of the founding of the People's Republic of China, an important milestone in the country's development. It is our honor to celebrate National Day and participate in a series of diverse celebratory activities.

Enrichment

We introduce a variety of training programmes and activities to appeal to the different interests of members.

Cadet Exchange Programme

During the reporting year, we successfully reinstated and executed a comprehensive range of exchange programs, both inbound and outbound, achieving remarkable success. These exchanges have played a pivotal role in fostering international camaraderie among our cadets, with notable programs including a special exchange to Korea from August 5 to 12, Japan from August 2 to 9 and the ICEP Singapore Exchange from November 10 to 17.

Furthermore, we had the privilege of hosting an inbound exchange program from August 4 to 11 in Hong Kong, welcoming approximately 22 participants. This included 2 escorting officers and 7 cadets from Sea Explorers of Korea, as well as 120 youths from 溫州. Noteworthy among these exchanges was the "Bound by Unity: Journey Across Million Miles" (同心同根萬里行) program organized by the Heart to Roots Association. This

initiative took 2 escorting officers and 11 cadets on a memorable journey to Beijing and Xian, China, from July 20 to 28.

Additionally, we received invitations from the HKSAR Government for mainland exchanges, including the “一帶一路沿岸城市青少年交流活動 2024 – 延續杭州亞運篇” in Hangzhou from March 28 to April 1 and the “慶祝中華人民共和國成立 75 周年暨愛國主義教育之「大灣區科創探索考察團」 on October 11 to 13.

Marine Guru Programme (MG Programme)

MG Programme is a bespoke bonding programme between the Marine Police of HKPF and HKSCC with the common objective of nurturing our youth as responsible citizens of Hong Kong and emphasis is placed on the practical application of maritime knowledge. In the reporting year, our cadets had continued to engage in a range of enriching activities, the Corps had periodically reviewed, modified and enhanced the MG Programme in ensuring that our cadets will be greatly benefited and will effectively achieve the programme objectives.

Community Service

Our engagement with the community has been robust, with active participation in a range of social charity events. Notably, we took part in significant activities including the Welcoming Ceremony of Xuelong 2 visiting Hong Kong, the CCB(Asia) Hong Kong Tennis Open 2024, the Remembrance Day Ceremony at Cenotaph, the Community Chest Flag Day, shoreline cleanups at Sai Kung, distributing lucky bags to elderly individuals living alone on off-shore islands and honoring Poppy Day etc.

Advancement

We cultivate a continuous development of the members and the Corps in the growing competitive youth sector.

Chinese Style Foot Drill (CSF)

Our Flag Party and Guard of Honor have completed the course of CSF and conducted the flag-raising ceremony in the report year. Under the leadership of DCO Cdr Ponthey YIP, a systematic training course and a team of qualified in-house instructors were installed which had effectively

developed to CSF II. With this impressive development, we eagerly implement CSF III in 2025.

Band Development

In the report year, HKSCC has continuously developed Drum Band and Military Band trainings. Our Corps focuses on the development of the youth, based on sound and serve values. Our Corps seeks to nurture a group of disciplined and well-mannered members who seek to develop their skills further by engaging in fun and exciting activities as well as leadership developing opportunities for all to grow together. Drum Band added one musical instrument, xylophone to its band. The Drum Band was invited to perform in School Passing Out Parade, Annual Camp, Flag-raising ceremony at HK Museum of The War Resistance and Coastal Defence and Annual Parade.

On the other hand, the Military Band has achieved an extraordinary year of development. The Military Band was invited to perform "懷舊金曲吹不停" with the Winds Maniacs Assemble at Tusan Wan Town Hall on Aug 18. The Military Band was also performed in "黃大仙區慶祝中華人民共和國成立 75 周年嘉年華暨制服推廣日" on Sep 29 and HKJB & HKIMT Joint Annual Ball on Nov 15.

National Security Education

The HKSAR Government has actively promoted national security education in recent years, as highlighted in the 2024 Policy Address. The emphasis is on enhancing awareness of national security among Hong Kong residents and fostering a culture of law abidance. As an integral part of Hong Kong's societal fabric, HKSCC is deeply involved in advancing national security and civic education through various programs such as the "國家安全訓練日教育營", "警隊 180 周年暨國家安全日", "民安隊國家安全日", "少年領袖團國家安全日", "全民國家安全教育日---香港懲教學院開放日", "國家安全教育日嘉年華" at the Kwun Tong District National Security Carnival 2024, the "「全民國家安全教育日」線上問答比賽" and the "香港社福界維護國家安全研討會".

Furthermore, activities such as visits to the Chinese PLA HK Garrison Exhibition Centre during the Ngong Shuen Chau Barracks Open Day, trips to the National Palace Museum, participation in the Flag-raising ceremony at the GBS and the HK Museum of the War Resistance and Coastal Defence and

involvement in the the Ceremony to Commemorate the Victory Day of the Chinese People's War of Resistance against Japanese Aggression at the Memorial Garden of Hong Kong City Hall are integral components of our efforts to promote national security education and civic awareness within the community.

CORPS' BACKGROUND

The Hong Kong Sea Cadet Corps began to take shape in 1967 by a group of officers of the former Hong Kong Royal Naval Reserve. The formation of the Corps took place on 16th February 1968 and incorporated under the Hong Kong Law (Chapter 1134 – Hong Kong Sea Cadet Corps Ordinance). The Hong Kong Sea Cadet Corps was modeled after and in affiliation with the Sea Cadet Corps of United Kingdom.

Since its inception, the Royal Navy in Hong Kong provided regular support for our officers and cadets, including training resources and facilities. On 1st July 1997, the Corps transformed into an independent uniformed youth organization of Hong Kong and has also been a full member of the International Sea Cadet Association since 1995.

AIMS

The Corps aims at providing nautical skill, team-building and discipline trainings to its cadet members through maritime activities and to equip them with self-respect, positive value, qualities of leadership, dedication to duty and civic awareness such that they will become contributing citizens of our community.

Apart from the normal scheduled training and outdoor activities, community services are also our main commitment. These include manpower assistance to the local charitable organizations for fund raising; providing cadets for crowd control duties during public celebrations and active participation in flag selling days.

MANAGEMENT & ORGANISATIONAL STRUCTURES

Policy and directive to run the Hong Kong Sea Cadet Corps are formulated by the Executive Committee under the authority of the Area Committee, which is at present chaired by Ms. LEUNG Tze-wai Jeanie and comprises renowned members of the Hong Kong community who have genuine interest in the promotion of sea training and activities for young people.

The Commanding Officer, Captain Rebecca CF YUEN who is appointed by the Area Committee is the overall operational commander of the Corps. The day-to-day administration is undertaken by the Chief Staff Officer assisted by a team of full-time staff at our Diamond Hill Headquarters.






Income and Expenditure 2023/24


